Premiere: The piano four hands version premiered by the child pianists Jeanne Leleu and Geneviève Durony, at the Société Musicale Indépendante, at the Salle Gaveau in Paris, on April 20, 1910. The orchestrated version premiered at the Théâtre des Arts in Paris, under the direction of Gabriel Grovlez, January 1912.

Most Recent LO Performance: The LO often performs excerpts but the most recent full performance was October 24, 2009 with Jason Weinberg conducting.
