On Saturday, March 17 at 11AM The Louisville Orchestra and guest conductor Keitaro Harada bring Prokofiev's classic children's story **Peter + the Wolf** to the Brown Theatre. This family favorite will come to life as Louisville's own Squallis Puppeteers enact the story with their larger-than-life puppets and the Louisville Orchestra performs the engaging score. Pre-concert activities by the Louisville Free Public Library, Terry Kelley the Balloon Man, The Louisville Zoo, and the Squallis Puppeteers begin at 10AM in the Lobby of the Brown Theatre and are free for all ticket holders.

**Peter + the Wolf** is a charming story of a young boy and his animal friends who have a great adventure and work together to escape the dangerous jaws of the wolf. Prokofiev wrote this score to teach children the different instruments in the orchestra by representing each character with its own instrument and musical motif.

Making his Louisville Orchestra debut, guest conductor **Keitaro Harada** is the Associate Conductor for the Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra as well as the Arizona Opera. He is a three time Solti Foundation U.S. Career Assistance Award winner and was one of six conductors selected to participate in the Bruno Walter National Conductor Preview in 2013.

**Squallis Puppeteers** have existed for twenty years as a collective of local artists and performers, and are dedicated to the handmade and the homespun. They have been making puppets, performing, and teaching children (and adults) in Louisville, Kentucky since 1997.
