Louisville, KY (3.13.18).... Teddy Abrams and The Louisville Orchestra present the final LG+E Music Without Borders Concerts and Neighborhood Series at the Ogle Center concerts of the 2017-18 season. **Music For Strings, Percussion + Celeste** will showcase the talents of the LO musicians on Thursday, April 12 at The Temple at 7:30PM; Friday, April 13 at The Jeffersonian at 7:30PM; and Saturday, April 14 at the Paul W. Ogle Cultural and Community Center on the campus of Indiana University Southeast at 7:30PM. The LG+E Music Without Borders Series and the Neighborhood Series at the Ogle Center are an ideal way to engage with the community through a shared musical adventure. The Louisville Orchestra brings short, thematic concerts to venues throughout the city, and into YOUR neighborhood.

Music For Strings, Percussion + Celeste features Richard Strauss' Suite in B-flat Major for 13 Wind Instruments and Igor Stravinsky's Octet both of which spotlight the LO's exceptional woodwinds in two delightful works. Strings, Percussion + Celeste will venture fearlessly into the most intense and expressive work by Hungarian composer Béla Bartók for a powerful finale to the series.
